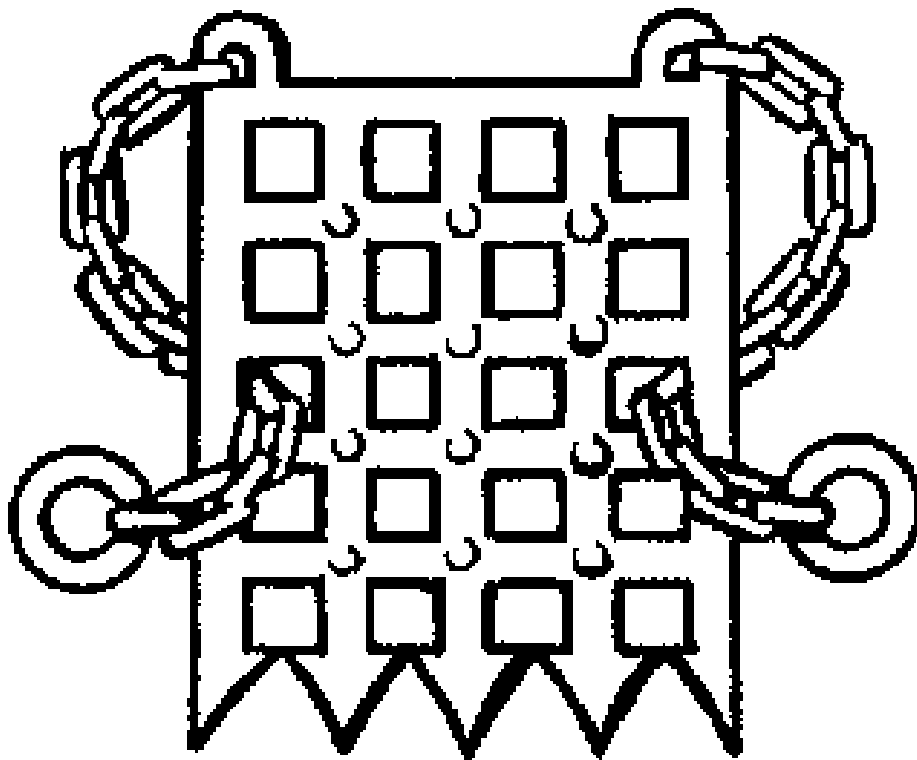

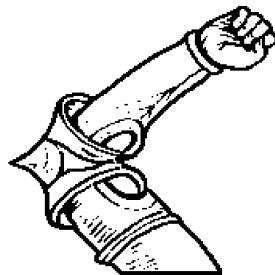

The Proposal

Excerpt from **ANTIR KINGDOM LAW**, Article V, Section B. *Awards and Orders*

1. The power to bestow patents, grants, awards of arms, and all other awards flows from the Crown. Any subject may make recommendations to the Crown regarding any level of award, and it is the duty of those with administrative responsibilities to bring forward the names of individuals deserving of recognition. No branch or other entity below Baronial level may bestow awards. *Shires and other branch entities may give scrolls of praise and recognition and other tokens.*

Proposal: A Shire Token

Purpose: To recognize General Excellence in Enrichment of, and Service to, the Shire of Cold Keep

Method of Choosing Recipients:

1) First Recipient to be selected by populace vote:

☆ Recommendations from the populace to be submitted to an impartial committee from within the geographical region of Prince George

☆ submission deadline no later than the October Council meeting

☆ submissions may be made by email or by hard copy to:

2) Successive Recipients to be chosen by a committee of all previous recipients based on their own observation and recommendations received from the populace of Cold Keep (ie - the second recipient will be chosen by the First Recipient, the third recipient will be chosen by the First and Second recipients, and so on)

☆ Recommendations from the populace of Cold Keep are encouraged as they are vital to the selection process: no one person can see everything another person does

☆ The populace of Cold Keep, for purposes of nominations and recommendations, is considered to be a member of the Shire of Cold Keep or the WolfPack

☆ A Letter of Recommendation **must** include justification of the nomination; submitting a name without giving reasons why that person is worthy of consideration will result in that submission being disregarded.

Conditions for Recipients:

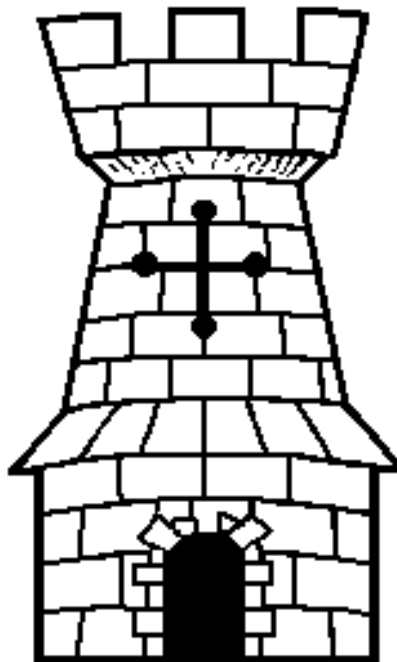
- ☆ Must be a geographical resident of Cold Keep (ie anyone within the geographical borders of Prince George, including the WolfPack)
- ☆ There will be a maximum of one recipient per year: note that there may be a year or more when there is no recipient
- ☆ A committee of all recipients of the Shire Token must select any new recipients based on their own observation and the recommendations of the populace of Cold Keep
- ☆ The populace of Cold Keep is encouraged to recommend new recipients

Proposed Badge: Sable, atop a tower argent flames proper

Special Token: A special token, called “The Guiding Light” is proposed for people who reside outside the geographical area of Prince George, and who have made a significant contribution to the enrichment of Cold Keep.

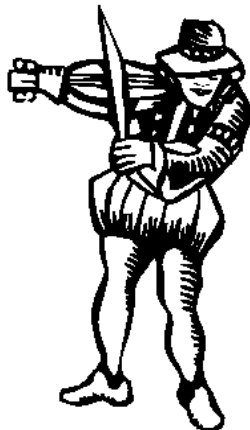
